East Kurdistan Citizens' Opinions on the Kurdistan Region

Monday, October 23, 2023

The Kurdistan Region's experience has been the subject of in-depth discussion in many countries and institutions, but little is known about its impact on Kurds in neighboring countries, including East Kurdistan (Iranian Kurds).

- What does this experience mean for the Kurds in the east Kurdistan?
- Does it make them afraid of repeting such an experience or encouraging them to fight for the establishment of an independent region in Iran? What are the Kurds of the east Kurdistan dissatisfied with the Kurdistan Regional Government?


These and many other questions were asked by the staff of the survey department of Draw Media Organization to the Kurds of the East and have yielded interesting results that you can see below;

The survey consists of three sections and 17 main questions and was supervised by Dr. Niaz Najmadin, Assistant Professor at Sulaimani University and it was sent online to the respondents. Due to political and security obstacles, the poll could not collect the votes of more than (300) three hundred people.

Below is a summary of the results and the full report is attached: - More than half of the respondents prefer to visit Sulaimani compared to other cities in the region.

- 32% of the respondents are unhappy with the treatment of the checkpoints in the region, 29% are satisfied with the treatment of checkpoints.
- 54% consider the experience of governing the region bad, Only 8% prefer regional governance experience
- 70% do not want the experience of governing the region to be transferred to East Kurdistan.
- 68% of respondents see the future of the region in danger and see internal conflict and regional states as the reason for its destruction.




Q2: Highest degree achieved


Q3: Gender




Q5: Current residence


Q6: Have you ever been to the Kurdistan Region?


Q7: Which city would you most like to visit?


Q8: When visiting or based on your knowledge of the Kurdistan Region, how are the treatment and experience at checkpoints?


Q9: Do you feel safe and secure in or when visiting the Kurdistan Region?


Q10: How do you assess the treatment of Kurdistan Region citizens towards citizens of the East Kurdistan?


Q11: During your visit to the Kurdistan Region, or according to your knowledge, how much has the Kurdistan Region developed?


Q12: How much do you agree with the statement: 'Social freedom in the Kurdistan Region is an incentive for me to visit the region?


Q13: How do you assess the experience of governing in Kurdistan region?


Q14: Do you support transferring the Kurdistan region's governance experience to the East?


Q15: How satisfied are you with the attitude of the Kurdistan Regional Government in dealing with the Iranian state?


Q16: How do you see the KRG's treatment of the eastern forces in the Kurdistan Region?


Q17: Which of these parties has the greatest influence on public opinion in the east?


Q18: To what extent do Kurdistan's media influence public opinion in the east?


Q19: To what extent do you agree with the statement that "the Kurdistan Region serves as a sanctuary for the Kurds of East Kurdistan?"


Q20: Which perspective do you favor regarding East Kurdistan (Iranian Kurdistan)?


Q21: Cultural-wise, which is the former?


Q22: Has the Kurdistan Region provided economic support and job opportunities to the residents of East Kurdistan?


Q23: Would you like to live in the Kurdistan Region?


Q24: How do you see the future of the Kurdistan Region?
